2. CHEMICAL IDENTIFICATION

3. HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

- None if pens are correctly used.
- Danger comes from deletion fluid only, classified T + R26/27/28-61. The product contains Dimethylformamide.
- Do not release the product to environment.

4. FIRST-AID MEASURES

- 4.1 Ingestion: Not applicable. If fluid is swallowed, drink water. Do not induce vomiting and call a physician.
- 4.2 Inhalation: Breath fresh air.
- 4.3 Contact with skin: Flush skin with water and soap.
- 4.4 Contact with eyes: Flush eyes with water. In case of irritation seek medical advice.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES
